General Role Description:

To be responsible for organising and delivering daytime and evening competitions in the arena at Peak 2020. As an Activities and Events team leader, you will be a crucial member of the Activities and Events team. You will report to and work closely with your manager and will be required to provide regular updates at team meetings. You will be required to work as a closely-knit team with the other team leaders, Managers, Coordinators and Directors to develop ideas from conception to delivery in 2020.

Key Responsibilities:

- To plan and organise a range of engaging, entertaining competitions based around the theme of the camp to take place in the Peak 2020 arena.
- To facilitate the delivery of competitions during the daytime and evening sessions, and to ensure these competitions are tailored to children and young people aged between 10 and 17 years.
- To participate in meetings with the On-Stage Production team, helping to develop ideas for the Peak 2020 programme, and to liaise with the Competitions Manager.
- To work alongside the Daytime Arena Activities Leader to compile an exciting, new arena activities programme.
- To lead and assist a team of activity staff in the delivery of these competitions, ensuring they are adapted to suit the needs of the participants.

General Responsibilities:

- To work effectively as a member of team, engaging with both the management team and the on-site activities staff.
- To deliver all activities in line with health and safety regulations, and the Scout and Guide Association's policies.
- To be enthusiastic about the Peak 2020 programme, and help to deliver an enjoyable, unforgettable camp experience for all participants.

Personal Attributes:

- You are creative, outgoing and enthusiastic, and can contribute new, imaginative competition ideas to the Peak 2020 programme.
- You are organised and methodical, and feel comfortable attending professional meetings to discuss ideas, which may be subject to scrutiny.
- You are able and willing to lead a team of activities staff to ensure a high standard of delivery of the competitions, and have previous experience of working with young people aged 10 – 17 years (this is desirable, but not necessary).
