General Role Description:

To be responsible for the organisation and running of daytime activities in the arena at Peak 2020. As an Activities and Events team leader, you will be a crucial member of the Activities and Events team. You will report to and work closely with your manager and will be required to provide regular updates at team meetings. You will be required to work as a closely-knit team with the other team leaders, Managers, Coordinators and Directors to develop ideas from conception to delivery in 2020.

Key Responsibilities:

- To plan and organise daytime activities to take place in the main arena, which incorporate and use the stage and sound/lighting infrastructures, and to tailor these activities to children and young people aged between 10 and 17 years.
- To offer a varied and unique activities programme of two 2.5 hour sessions per day, based around the theme of the camp.
- To participate in meetings with the On-Stage Production team, helping to develop ideas for activities and assist fellow leaders in the organisation of the activity programme.
- To effectively lead and assist a team of activity staff in the delivery of these sessions to ensure the provision of high quality activities.

General Responsibilities:

- To work effectively as a member of team, engaging with both the management team and the on-site activities staff.
- To deliver all activities in line with health and safety regulations, and the Scout and Guide Association's policies.
- To be enthusiastic about the Peak 2020 programme, and help to deliver an enjoyable, unforgettable camp experience for all participants.

Personal Attributes:

- You are a creative and innovative individual, and will bring new, imaginative activities ideas to the On-Stage Production team.
- You are organised and methodical, and feel comfortable attending professional meetings to discuss ideas, which may be subject to scrutiny.
- You have excellent leadership and teamwork skills, and would be able to lead a team of activity staff to ensure effective delivery of the activities programme.
- You will have some experience of delivering activities for children and young people aged 10 to 17 years – this is desirable but not necessary.
- You are a positive and enthusiastic person, who can confidently and passionately promote Peak 2020.
