

# **ROLE DESCRIPTION**

## **HEALTH & WELFARE TEAM- FOOD SAFETY ADVISER**

### **Health and Welfare at Peak 2020:**

The aim of the Health and Welfare team is to provide a team available to staff and campers 24 hours a day who can provide first aid, emergency medical response and welfare support services to all participants and staff at Peak 2020. The Health and Welfare team is responsible for both Mobile and Static Medical and welfare services.

It is important to note that wherever possible we will allocate staff to their preferred of role, but we may need to reallocate staff to different role depending on requirements.

In this role you will be working as a member of the Health and Welfare Support team as a Food Safety Advisor. As a member of the Support team it should be noted that in addition to your primary role that you may also be asked to support the remainder of the team, and in the case of a Major Incident, report directly to the nominated RVP to assist as directed.

### **General Role Requirements:**

The Role will include, but not exclusively the following essential duties and responsibilities:

To advise camp participants on issues of food hygiene and the control of gastro-intestinal infections.

This will be achieved by

1. Liaison with staff providing catering facilities, review or advise on written food safety management systems.
2. Early contact with groups attending camp & provision of information to their catering teams.
3. Contact with other teams to provide advice to limit infection. In particular:
  - a. In respect of the provision of potable water
  - b. Hand washing facilities and the use of antibacterial soap
  - c. Removal of animal faeces from the camp site.
  - d. Provision of signage warning of E. coli risk and advising on hand washing. Including information for campers.
  - e. Supply of adequate ice blocks for exchange.
  - f. Visits to all units on camp to look at catering operation and to encourage good standards through a best camp kitchen competition.
4. Investigation alongside the H&W managers of incidents of gastro-enteritis during camp & advice on limiting the further spread of infection.
5. Investigation of any complaints concerning the health standards of catering facilities supplied by Camp staff.

### **Essential Role Requirements:**

1. Hold an appropriate qualification in food hygiene
2. Hold a Valid DBS
3. Be a member of either the Scout or Guide Association
4. Be over 18 at the start of Peak
5. Be prepared to attend weekend meetings and training sessions (minimum of 2)

6. Support the aims of Peak camps
7. Able to complete and appropriately file confidential documentation
8. Prepared to work as part of a team
9. Attend debrief meeting

This position will be advertised, interviewed for and appointed in line with Peak 2020 policy.

The role will be directly responsible to the deputy & assistant director health & welfare
