

Role Description - Adventurous Activities Deputy Manager

Adventurous Activities Peak 2020

The aim of the activities team will be to provide adventurous activities to the campers at Peak 2020. The role of deputy manager will require working closely with the manager and outside parties to deliver a quality programme for the campers.

General Role requirements:

- 1 You will be responsible for working with adventurous activities team members
- 2 You will be responsible to liaise and work with third party organisations
- 3 Assist in building and training team members where required
- 4 Hold a valid DBS
- 5 Be over 18 at the start of Peak
- 6 Be prepared to attend meetings and training events
- 7 Support the aims of the Peak Camps

Essential Role Requirements:

- 1 Have a good knowledge of one or more of the activities involved
- 2 Be able to manage multiple events in one location
- 3 Be prepared to work in teams to provide the activities required
- 4 Help and assist in team building
- 5 Attend team briefings
- 6 Ability to work under pressure
- 7 Ability to complete paperwork and rotas
- 8 Understand the Scout and Guide safety regulations regarding adventurous activities
- 9 Understand the safety involved in the activities
- 10 Prioritise work
- 11 Be able to react to situations with calm thoughts
- 12 Be able to respond to any other reasonable request by the adventurous activity manager
