#### **General Role Description: 14-17 Activities Team Leader**

To be responsible for **14-17 Activity Provision** at Peak 2020. As an Activities and Events team leader, you will be a crucial member of the Activities and Events team. You will report to and work closely with your manager and will be required to provide regular updates at team meetings. You will be required to work as a closely-knit team with the other team leaders, Managers, Coordinators and Directors to develop ideas from conception to delivery in 2020.

#### **Key Responsibilities:**

- To create a program of Activities for the 14-17 participants
- To be responsible for the financial arrangements
- To manage the Participant entry to ensure only the authorised campers are allowed within the Activity zones
- Work closely with the Activities Team
- To prepare Risk Assessments for all planned activities

**General responsibilities:**

- Support the provision of Activities and Entertainments to enhance the experience for the participants.
- Manage the delivery of the Events in conjunction with the 14-17 A&E Manager
- Maintain compliance with health & safety policies and procedures.
- To liaise with the 14-17 Subcamp Team to ensure a continuity and crossover of provision
- Assist the 14-17 A&E Manager in recruiting and appointing a Team
- You will work fully in conjunction with the Team to ensure delivery of 14-17 Activities and Events
