These positions should be advertised, interviewed for and appointed in line with Peak 2020 policy

Make provision for campers, staff and visitors who have additional needs to ensure that they have full integration into the Peak 2020 Camp and to liaise with Health & Welfare, Site Manager and Activities , Events Manager and campers manager to ensure that specific medical needs are adequately catered for.

Risk Assessment and Health and Welfare

Create an environment where all the younger sections, leaders and staff will enjoy the camp in a safe and happy way.

Ensure that a full risk assessment takes place within all sub teams / activities and ensure that all health and welfare requirements are fulfilled in line with Peak camps and association guidelines
