

ROLE DESCRIPTION HEALTH & WELFARE TEAM – CLINICAL HEALTH MANAGER

Health and Welfare at Peak 2020:

The aim of the Health and Welfare team is to provide a team available to staff and campers 24 hours a day who can provide first aid, emergency medical response and welfare support services to all participants and staff at Peak 2020. The Health and Welfare team is responsible for both Mobile and Static Medical and welfare services.

It is important to note that wherever possible we will allocate staff to their preferred role, but we may need to reallocate you to different role depending on requirements.

We are looking to appoint a health & welfare- clinical health manager for Peak 2020

The Role will include, but not exclusively the following essential duties and responsibilities:

General Role Requirements:

- Work with the H&W deputy director and other managers to establish clinical & operational procedures/policies to support H&W team at Peak 2020
- Deputies for the deputy director where required
- Assist with logistical matters including stock & staff management issues
- Work with the health & welfare management team to coordinate the 'Health' aspect of the health & welfare services (Appoint team leader(s) if applicable)
- Appoint a first aid team leader
- Manage a 24hour response team
- Coordinate medical services for Peak2020 (including; GP services, clinics, treatment bays)
- Recruit health care professionals and team members to support Peak2020 H&W team
- Attend & support pre-peak training events (minimum of 2)
- Able to work as part of a team providing health & welfare to staff, leaders & participants
- Complete any specific training required for Peak 2020
- Ability to work under pressure

Essential Role Requirements:

- Hold a Health Care Professional registration or equivalent
- Work within your own scope of practice
- Prepared to provide clinical support & advice
- Be over 18 at the start of Peak 2020
- Take a lead role in any Major Incident
- Support the aims of Peak camps

This position will be advertised, interviewed for and appointed in line with Peak 2020 policy.

The role will be directly responsible to the deputy & assistant director health & welfare
