

ROLE DESCRIPTION HEALTH & WELFARE TEAM -SUPPORT TEAM MANAGER

Health and Welfare at Peak 2020:

The aim of the Health and Welfare team is to provide a team available to staff and campers 24 hours a day who can provide first aid, emergency medical response and welfare support services to all participants and staff at Peak 2020. The Health and Welfare team is responsible for both mobile and static medical and welfare services.

It is important to note that wherever possible we will allocate staff to their preferred role, but we may need to reallocate you to different role depending on requirements.

We are looking to appoint a health & welfare- support team manager for Peak 2020
The Role will include, but not exclusively the following essential duties and responsibilities:

General Role Requirements:

- Work with the Health & Welfare management team to deliver the team support aspect of the health & welfare services.
- Coordinate an admin/support/control team (appoint a team leader(s) if applicable)
- Manage a 24hr support/control capability
- Assist with administration pre, during and after Peak 2020
- Attend & support pre-peak training events (minimum of 2)
- Ability to work under pressure
- Able to work as part of a team providing health & welfare to staff, leaders & participants
- Complete any specific training required for Peak 2020

Essential Role Requirements:

- Be over 18 at the start of Peak 2020
- Support the aims of Peak camps

This position will be advertised, interviewed for and appointed in line with Peak 2020 policy.

The role will be directly responsible to the deputy & assistant director health & welfare
