Fire Team Manager - Role Description

Responsible to: Safety, Health and Welfare Director

Responsible for: Taking all practicable steps to reduce the risk of fire at Peak 2020 and have the necessary team and equipment in place to deal with any incident that may occur.

Role & Responsibilities:

- Recruit a team of suitably qualified or trained individuals to carry out the necessary duties for the team.
- Liaise with all members of the Senior Management Team and other managers to ensure a safe Peak 2020.
- Support the Safety, Health and Welfare Director, Deputy Director and other team Directors and Managers as necessary by providing advice of all relevant current Fire legislation which may affect the camp.
- Ensure that the site planning incorporates the camping guidelines of both Associations and adheres to current legislation and the wishes of the Chatsworth Estate Management Team
- Liaise with the local Fire and other Emergency Services and Chatsworth Estate when necessary to provide support in case of a fire.
- Create, publish and implement a procedure to manage the outbreak of fire at Peak 2020.
- In cooperation with the Safety, Health and Welfare Director help draft and implement the emergency evacuation procedure.
- Plan and maintain strategically positioned fire points on site in liaison with the Site Infrastructure Director.
- Advise all campers about the safety & storage of gas supplies & other dangerous liquids or fuels (petrol, diesel, paraffin etc) being used on camp.
- Assist in writing and implement a smoking policy for the camp.
